 2 Able to move 4 extremities voluntarily or on command

Respirations:
 2 Able to deep breathe and cough freely

Circulation:
 2 BP = 20% of pre-sedation level
 1 BP = 20-49% of pre-sedation level

Pulse Oximetry:
 2 > 92% on room air
 1 Needs oxygen to maintain 92%
 0 < 92% with oxygen

Consciousness:
 2 Answers questions appropriately/aware of location
 1 Arousable on calling

Level of Consciousness [LOC] KEY

1 = Alert and oriented
 2 = Mild sedation, oriented, able to answer questions
 3 = Moderate sedation, easily arousable, maintains patent airway, responds to physical/verbal stimuli
 4 = Deep sedation, depressed consciousness, NOT easily aroused but maintains patent airway.
 5 = Deep sedation, unconscious, unarousable, possible partial or complete loss of ability to maintain patent airway
