Tricyclic antidepressants	<p>Concurrent use may increase therapeutic and toxic effects of both drugs, possibly due to increased catecholamine receptor sensitivity.</p> <p>Onset of tricyclics may be accelerated.</p> <p>Rarely reported.</p>	Monitor TSH levels; monitor patient response to tricyclics.
Estrogen products	Increased serum thyroxine-binding globulin. Little clinical evidence available.	May need to increase thyroid hormone dose if estrogens are given.
Warfarin	<p>Increased metabolism of vitamin K-dependent clotting factors.</p> <p>Often a clinically significant reaction when titrating thyroid therapy.</p>	Monitor international normalized ratio (INR) when initiating or changing dose of thyroid hormone. Less incidence in euthyroid patient.
